

- 1. General Meeting: Did anyone from Figure Skating work at Oktober fest? Dawn will forward the email to Jodi and she will check in anyone worked for CFSC.
- 2. Called to Order: 6:07pm
- 3. Consent agenda A motion was made by Jessica S to approve the consent agenda and 2nd Holli motion carried
 - a. Secretary's Report (Jessica) Minutes to the September meeting and presidents report attachment
 - b. Treasurer's Report (Tricia) Income statement through September 2023
 - c. Hockey Report (Katy)- See attached from Amy who attending the October meeting.

4. President's Report (Amy): We need to remember to turn the lights off and lock up our side of the rink when we are the last ones on the ice. They also want us to resurface the ice if we are the last on the ice. We will need to continue to get people trained so that we have people to fulfill this duty. Theresa Wahl's husband is going to get trained on Zamboni. Do we want to purchase subscriptions to Canva (\$119 for 1 person) for our newsletters, Google Doc Storage (200 GB for one year \$29.99) so that we have enough room in our Drive to store our documents and Remind (for additional characters to send out messages). A motion was made by Tricia to approve the purchase of additional storage on our google doc storage and 2nd Jessica S – motion carried. Amy will purchase the extra storage and send the receipt to Tricia to be reimbursed. I have reached out to the sign company. When I get the cost, I will send it out to be approved.  Vice President's Report (Holli):
- 6. Committee Reports:
 - a. Registration (Jodi/Kayla): We did not get our money from hockey for registration just yet.
 - b. Competition (Katy/Holli): Secured officials, opened registration, Sent out invitations via email and Facebook to 75 clubs, Due to the high level judges, we are able to offer up a test session after competition - through gold singles and skating skills and up to pre-silver pattern dances. The hope is that it brings in more applicants to our competition. Committee meeting on 10/29 - working on open positions and delegating additional tasks. Will look at registration to reach out to parents for concession shifts, Let me know if you know anyone that might be interested in running, Started reaching out for donations, any suggestions is welcome
 - c. Testing (Dawn): nothing else.
 - d. Hockey Report (Katy): See above
 - e. Spring Show (Jessica, Tricia & Mackenzie): We met again on October 22nd for committees. Another meeting on Sunday October 29th with the Show committee. We are raising the rates for LTS \$50, Jr Club \$75, Sr Club \$90. A motion was made by Katy to approve price of the registration fee to increase to the LTS \$50, Jr Club and Sr Club \$90 and 2nd Jodi motion carried
 - f. Learn to Skate (Jodi/Amanda): We held a coaches meeting on October 15th. Most parents/guardians that attended requested a paper copy of the handbook. We went over many of the highlights in the handbook and shared information about: the CFSC competition, Skate for a Cause, steps to find a private coach, bingo, and the ice show. Brian from Play it Again Sports was also in attendance with Wilson skates for sale for \$50. We also needed to adjust the calendar a bit to

accommodate for many of our LTS coaches being unavailable on Sunday, October 22nd. An open skate/skills practice was held in place of regular skating lessons that day, and the end of this LTS session will be extended to December 3rd.

- g. Bingo (Holli): Holli has not been able to find a steady caller to replace Wendy so Wendy will continue until we need to find another caller. Concessions are going well with baked goods.
- h. Events (Jessica S.): An ad and Google form will be in the November newsletter to see who can participate in the Christmas parade and to get contact information so I can communicate with families. The theme is Christmas movies and we will be doing Nightmare Before Christmas. We will need a truck, trailer and families/skaters to help decorate. When would be a good date for this? Anyone have a pull barn we could do it in? What has the club done in the past? I don't want to re-invent the wheel. I want to work smarter not harder. Also, do I need a budget for this? What should I purchase.

- j. Marketing (Kayla): Tricia received the domain renewal and will send to Kayla to update.

 - b. Policy on guest skaters on club ice They have to have a USFSA membership, sign a waiver and pay a fee. A motion was made by Jodi to approve to charge guest skaters to skate on our club ice \$15/hr and 2nd Tricia motion carried
 - c. Basic 6, Jr & Sr Club parent meeting in November November 19th at 4:15pm
 - d. The mirrors for the rink have been ordered.
