SEASON LESSON INFORMATION

▪ 30 Minute Group Lesson by level with Coaches and Helpers

▪ Open skating time to practice skills at various times throughout the season
Parents must be present during this time.

▪ 30 minute individual lesson with club approved coach for 16 lessons

▪ Open skate skill practice time during designated Jr/Senior Club ice times
Parents must be present during this time.

▪ Two 30 minute individual lessons with an available skater selected coach or coaches for 32 lessons

▪ Open skate skill practice time during designated Jr/Senior Club ice times

Parents are required to stay during lesson times due to the skill level and age of the skaters

Optional Additional Individual Lesson Time: arranged by the coach and paid by the skater

*Optional Additional Individual Lesson Time: During Junior or Senior Club Ice with Coach
Time is arranged with coach individually and paid by skater (not included in club ice fees)*

Optional Additional Individual Lesson Time: Private Individual Lessons with a Coach— Time is arranged with coach individually and paid by skater (not included in club ice fees)

TESTING

Testing occurs during group lessons
1 x per session

Testing occurs at various testing locations and is paid for by the skater for pre-pre skating skills. Skater also pays a fee to the coach for attending the test session. Free Skate levels are tested within the club.

Testing occurs at various testing locations and is paid for by the skater. Skater also pays a fee to the coach for attending the test session. [Most common testing includes: Skating Skills and Singles]

COACHES

▪ LTS Director Oversees Program and Assists Skaters & Coaches

▪ Coaches— 14+ yrs. of age, at Senior Club Level, and completed LTS certification course

▪ Helpers— 12+ yrs. of age & at Senior Club Level

Junior Club Coach **Minimum** Qualifications:

- 16+ yrs. of age, successfully coached LTS, completed shadowing of Senior Club coaches and Continuing Education Requirements (CER), and must carry insurance
- Has passed Bronze Skating Skills and Pre-Bronze Singles/ Adults 21+/51+: passed Silver Skating Skills & Silver Singles

Senior Club Coach **Minimum** Qualifications:

- Has passed Standard Pre-Silver Skating Skills and Bronze Singles testing : Adults 21+/51+ passed Intermediate Skating Skills and Gold Singles or is grandfathered in as a coach (Must carry insurance)
- **Preferred Qualifications::** Has passed Standard Silver Skating Skills and Pre-Silver Singles testing : Adults 21+/51+ passed Novice Skating Skills and Intermediate Singles (Must carry insurance)

PARENTS

Work 2 CFSC Bingos, 0 assessment hours for years 1 & 2 , 10 assessment hours per skater for 3-5 years or pay the buy-out option & work team responsibilities (Cleaning, Steel Game, Open Skate)

Work 2 CFSC Bingos, Complete 20 Assessment Hours or pay the buy-out, Work team responsibilities (Cleaning, Steel Game, Open Skate) [50 Assessment hours cap per family]

Work 2 CFSC Bingos, Complete 25 Assessment Hours per skater or pay the buy-out, Work team responsibilities (Cleaning, Steel Game, Open Skate) [50 Assessment hours cap per family]
