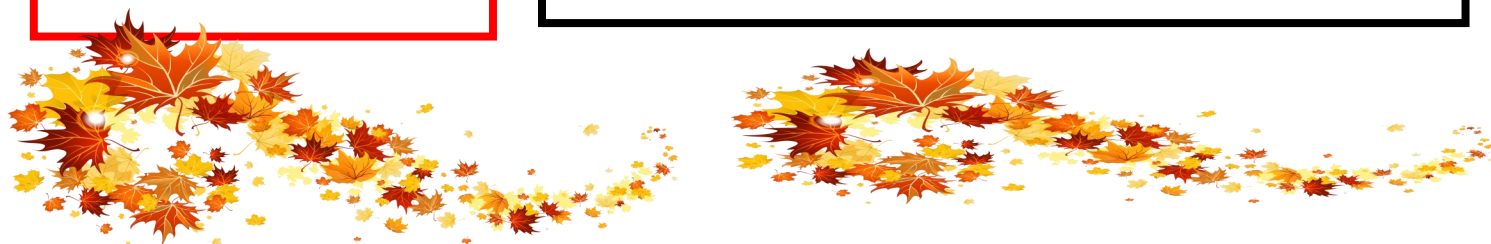

# September Board Meeting Minutes

1. General Meeting: Nothing
2. Called to Order: 6:05pm
3. Consent agenda **A motion was made by Jessica Samb to approve the consent agenda and 2<sup>nd</sup> Katy – motion carried**
  - a. Secretary's Report (Jessica) – Minutes to the August meeting
